3. **Requirements** to be consideration of the scholarship award, candidates must:
- i. Be a nationality of a country that has diplomatic relations with Japan
  - ii. Be born on or after 2<sup>nd</sup> April, 1985
  - iii. Possess Academic Background or
  - iv. Master's course/Doctoral Course (first Phase & Second phase) who has been awarded with an oversea degree similar to master degree and has been involved in research studied at Universities.
  - v. Be willing to study Japanese Language
  - vi. Possess medical Certificate
  - vii. Complete the application form
  - viii. Obtain the student Visa at the Japanese Diplomatic mission or those that have other residence status (Permanent Resident, "long-term Residence", etc.) must change it to Student Status and Re-enter japan.
4. Candidates must complete application form and submit alongside his/her documents to Japanese Diplomatic mission in Nigeria before the deadline 14th **June, 2019**. (Both origin and one copy of each and 2 copies of Certificate of Language proficiency).
5. The MEXT Scholarship will be responsible for the following:
- a. Allowance
  - b. Education Fees
  - c. Travelling Expenses Transportation to and from Japan.
