Nigeria's Annual Education Conference (NAEC) is organised by the Federal Ministry of Education with the support of its partners.

The main **objectives** of the conference are to:

- a) communicate research and evidence to strengthen education policies and practices, and
- b) bring together stakeholders in education policy-making in Nigeria to promote a culture of sharing evidence and open discussion.

The themes and sub-themes for the 2019 NAEC

The theme is *Education for Sustainable Livelihoods: A Systems Approach to Strengthening* the Sector for Productivity and Global Competitiveness.

The sub-themes are as follows:

- 1. **Curriculum and Instruction Strengthening for Greater Competence** the central question here is **'what are we teaching'**?
- 2. Capacity Development For Productivity And Effectiveness the central question here is, 'who is teaching?'
- 3. Infrastructure And Resources the central question undergirding this sub theme is, 'what tools are they using and how are they accessing those tools? The cross cutting issues relating to all sub-thematic areas and to be addressed by all included:
- ➤ The role of policy at the three tiers of government federal, state and local; and in particular, the importance of evidence-based policymaking
- ➤ Governance (Politics and Policy) accountability and transparency issues.
- Learning outcomes as an indicator of national development;
- Adopting an innovation-mind-set/mainstreaming innovative thinking;
- Addressing funding gaps and potential opportunities for resource mobilisation; and
- Mainstreaming the discussion across all academic levels (Early Childhood, Primary, Secondary, Tertiary, and specifically TVET)
- Addressing Inclusiveness in Education.
