## Nomination requirements

To qualify for the Prize, the short film should:



not exceed 4 minutes in length



not participated in another competition before



not undermine human, religious or national values



be subtitled in one of ICESCO's three official languages  
(Arabic, English and French)



The film may contain natural sounds or music without audible  
speech (nature and animal films)
