THE SCHOLARSHIP COVERS:

Tuition fees, International flight (once in a year economy class), Monthly allowance (800 AZN- includes meals, accommodation and cost of utilities), Medical insurance, Visa and Registration cost. Applications must be accompanied by the official letter of the candidate's institution and submitted to the **European Affairs Division** of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs on or before **10th February, 2020.**

- ❖ All the documents required should be translated into English or Russian language and notarized.

- Candidates will be informed about the results by early July, 2020
