- Additionally, an application for postgraduate programme must be accompanied by a study/research plan and for MPhil/Phd, the name of the proposed supervisor(s) in Mauritius
- All candidates must submit the fully completed Application form and documents listed under section 6 as part of their application to Federal Scholarship Board, Abuja on or before 26th of May, 2021

Eligibility Criteria for Candidates

- Must be a Nigerian
- Age Limits Undergraduates -- 18 years to 25 years

Masters ---- 35years MPhil/PhD ---- 40 years

- Health Certificate is important from a recognized Government Hospital
- Good WAEC result for Undergraduate with mostly As
- Master and PhD, minimum of second class Upper (2.1)
