- All candidates must submit the fully completed Application form and document listed under section 1- 6 as part of their application to Federal Scholarship Board, Abuja on or **before 20th of February, 2022**

Eligibility Criteria for Candidates

- Must be Nigerian
- Age limit- Undergraduates – 18 years to 25 years
Master -----35 years
MPhil/PhD -----40 years
- Health Certificate is important from a recognized Government Hospital
- Good WAEC result for undergraduates with mostly As
- Master and PhD, minimum of second class upper (2.1)
