- All candidates must submit the fully completed Application form and document listed under section 1- 6 as part of their application to Federal Scholarship Board, Abuja on or before 20<sup>th</sup> of February, 2022

- Must be Nigerian
- Age limit- Undergraduates 18 years to 25 years

- Good WAEC result for undergraduates with mostly As
- Master and PhD, minimum of second class upper (2.1)
