- 4. An Applicant may either obtain a conditional offer (letter of admission) from their chosen Mauritian public HEI and submit this along with the scholarship application or
- b. summit an acknowledgment notice from a Mauritian public HEI that application for seat has been made and the appropriate application fees has been paid.
- 5. All candidates must submit the fully completed application form and document listed under section 1-6 as part of their application to Federal Scholarship Board, Abuja on or before 19th May 2023
- 6. Eligibility Criteria for Candidates
 - i. Must be Nigerian
 - ii. Undergraduate should be above 18years of age and should not have reached their 26th birthday by on 01 Jan, 2024
 - iii. Postgraduate 35
 - iv. Health Certificate is important from a recognized Government Hospital
 - v. Good WAEC result for undergraduate
 - vi. Master and PhD, minimum of second class upper (2.1)
