Programme: Foundations of Education Sector Planning

Date: 2nd October, 2024 - 22nd July, 2025, with 10 – 12 hours per week

Objective: To provide professionals with the fundamentals of educational planning, which includes approaches and rationales of education sector, analysis of data for the design of effective education sector plans.

Organizer: UNESCO International Institute for Educational Planning (IIEP), an international training and research institute in educational planning. The Institute has been developing the capacities of education professionals responsible for the planning and management of systems through training, technical assistance, policy research, knowledge sharing.

Target Participants: Staff of Ministries of Education, governmental bodies, regional or local levels officials working in the field of educational planning, NGOs and developmental partners

Criteria:

- i. must have relevant professional work experience as practitioner, trainer, or researcher in field related to educational planning and management;
- ii. holds a three-year post-secondary education diploma (bachelor's degree or equivalent) in field related to social sciences (education, economics, political sciences or statistics);
- iii. must read, write and speak fluently in either English or French;
- iv. possess good computer skills in Microsoft Word and Excel; and
- v. must have successfully completed the introductory course (a self-spaced course on descriptive statistics.)

Programme Tuition Fee: 2,500 USD per participant, to be paid **on** or **before** 28th June, 2024 deadline.

Award: IIEP Diploma will be awarded to participants who successfully complete the programme.
