- 3. All applicants must have applied for at least one full-time on -campus programme at a public Higher Education Institution (HEIs) of their choice (listed under Section 8)
- 4 a. An Applicant may either obtain a conditional offer (letter of admission) from their chosen Mauritian public HEI and summit this along with the scholarship application or b. Summit an acknowledgment notices from a Mauritian public HEI that application for seat has been made and the appropriate application fees has been paid
- 5. All candidates must submit the fully completed application form and document listed under section 1-6 as part of their application to Federal Scholarship Board, Abuja on or before 19th April 2024.
- 6. Eligibility Criteria for Candidate
 - i. Must be a Nigerian
 - ii Undergraduate should be above 18 years of age and should not have reached their 26th birthday by 01 Jan. 2025.
 - iii. Postgraduate should not have reached their 40th year birthday by 01 Jan. 2025
 - iv. Health Certificate is important from a recognized Government Hospital.
 - v. Good WAEC result for undergraduate
 - vi. Masters and PhD, minimum of second class upper (2.1)
