## Application procedures:

2. The application form is obtainable from the websites below and must be filled electronically, printed and signed: <u>http://ministry-education.govmu.org</u> or http://highereducationmauritius.com

3. All applicants must have applied for at least one full-time on-campus programme at a public Higher Education Institution (HEIs) of their choice (listed under Section 7 of 8)

4.(a) An Applicant may either obtain a conditional offer (letter of admission) from their chosen Mauritian public HEI and submit this along with the scholarship application or

(b) Submit an acknowledgement notice from a Mauritian public HEI that the application for the seat has been made and the appropriate application fees have been paid

5. All candidates must submit the fully completed application form and documents listed under sections 1-6 to Federal Scholarship Board, Abuja, on or before 20<sup>th</sup> February, 2025

6. Eligibility Criteria for Candidate

- i. Must be a Nigerian
- ii. Undergraduates should be above 18<sup>th</sup> years of age and should not have reached their 26<sup>th</sup> birthday by 01 January 2026
- iii. Postgraduates should not have reached their 40<sup>th</sup> year birthday by 01 January 2026
- iv. Health Certificate is important from a recognised Government Hospital
- v. Good WAEC result for undergraduate
- vi. Masters and PhD, minimum of Second Class Upper (2.1)
