### **Application procedures:**

3. All applicants must have applied for at least one full-time on –campus programme at a public Higher Education Institution (HEIs) of their choice (listed under Section 7 of 8)

4. (a) An Applicant may either obtain a conditional offer (letter of admission) from their chosen Mauritian public HEI and submit this along with the scholarship application or

(b) Summit an acknowledgement notice from a Mauritian public HEI that application for seat has been made and the appropriate application fees has been paid

5. All candidates must submit the fully completed application form and documents listed under section 1-6 to Federal Scholarship Board, Abuja on or before 26<sup>th</sup> March, 2026

### **6. Eligibility Criteria for Candidates**

i. Must be a Nigerian

ii. Undergraduate should be above 18<sup>th</sup> years of age and should not have reached their 26<sup>th</sup> birthday by 01 January 2027

iii. Postgraduate should not have reached their 40<sup>th</sup> year birthday by 01 January 2027

iv. Health Certificate is important from a recognized Government Hospital

v. Good WAEC result for undergraduate accompanied with an A'LEVEL certificate.

vi. Masters and PhD, minimum of Second Class Upper (2.1)
